Streets of Red, White & Blue is a patriotic community service program provided by your Optimist Club of Perdido Bay to raise funds to support youth activities in Lillian and surrounding communities.



Wouldn't it look nice to have the streets of Lillian lined with flags during national flag holidays?

Optimist Club of Perdido Bay will provide a 3x5 American flag on a 10-foot pole in front of your home so that it will proudly fly on the following five national holidays: Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, Labor Day and Veterans Day.

How are the flags installed?

Prior to Memorial Day, we will come to your yard and drive a receiver into the ground approximately 5 ft. from the curb, or a location of your choice, careful to avoid any sprinkler systems or pet electric fence systems. We will make a small mark on your curb so we can quickly locate and install the flagpole on each holiday.

The Optimist Club of Perdido Bay is responsible for replacement of any soiled, damaged or stolen flags.

Who will benefit from the proceeds of this program?

All proceeds will be used by your Optimist Club of Perdido Bay to support local youth in becoming tomorrow's better citizens. A few of our projects are listed below.
